



The Minnesota Hockey District and USA Hockey will be posting the Coaching Education Program (CEP) clinics for the 2007-2008 season on its respective websites: www.usahockey.com and www.minnesotahockey.org starting in late August and early September.

Coaches may take Level 1 on Friday and Level 2 on Saturday OR Coaches may take Level 1 on Friday and Level 3 on Saturday. If a Coach takes Level 1 and 3, stickers for Level 3 will not be issued at the clinic where Level 2 is completed. This is allowed for flexibility in scheduling your clinics to get all levels required.

All information on the coaching program is available on the USA Hockey site under the Coaches Section.

Coaches Certification is valid for three seasons:

2004/05	Dec. 31, 2007
2005/06	Dec. 31, 2008

Continuing Education Requirements:

*Coaches with Level 1 or 2 certifications must progress to the next level within 3 years.

*Coaches with Level 3 certification must complete one of the following options within 3 years:

- Attend another level 3 clinic
- Complete the online recertification (www.usahockey.org)
- Attend a USA Hockey Continuing Ed. Course (i.e. skills, high performance or goalie workshop)
- Attend Level 4 Clinic
- Level 4 coaches require no recertification.

Level 4 clinic information:

DEC in Duluth, Minnesota
Must have levels 1, 2, 3 to participate.
