Important Information

- Only Centennial colors can be worn (black / white / red / grey).
- All socks worn must be a matching pair of CYHA issued socks (from previous years). No solid colors.
- No Names or Stickers on Jersey or Helmets

Important Information

- Tryout Results will be Posted at the Arena and on the CYHA WEBSITE by 7Am the day following the tryout.
- You have one week prior to Tryouts to change your Tryout level or Declared position (Bantam Only).
- B Boys tryouts will have group assignments posted on the CYHA website and posted at the Centennial arena on Friday Sept. 25th

Important Information

- Please arrive at the arena 1/2 hour before your scheduled ice time to get checked in.
- Each player must check in at the check in table before each session to ensure placement in the rotation and receive information on Jersey color for the day.

A Boys Tryouts

Squirts: 1 hr Drills / 2 hr Scrimmage

PeeWee / Bantams: 3 hr Scrimmage

- Skaters or goalies may be moved to the B level tryout after the 2nd hour by Evaluators
- Evaluators will select Top 20 skaters and up to 3 Goalies will advance to A Phase II
- Non-Parent coaches may select up to 2 additional skaters and 1 Goalie to advance to A Phase II

Girls Tryouts

U10: 1 hr Drills, 1 hr Scrimmage

U12: 1 hr Drills, 2 hrs Scrimmage

U14: 3 hrs Scrimmage

- U10 & U12: 20 Skaters and up to 3 Goalies advance to Phase 2
- U14 A Upper: 20 Skaters and up to 3 Goalies advance to Phase 2. All other U14 will go to U14 A Lower Phase II

B Boys Phase I (part 1)

Squirts / PeeWee: 1 hr Drills / 2 hr Scrimmage

Bantams: 3 hr Scrimmage

- Top 15 skaters will move to the B1 Phase II
- Evaluators will identify the players being placed on the C team for Squirts and PeeWee
- The evaluators will also identify 30 skaters to return for a final 1 hour scrimmage

B Boys Phase I (part 2)

At this final 1 hour scrimmage the evaluators will determine:

- A. If there is enough talent at this level to support a second Competitive B1 team.
- B. If there IS a second B1 team at that level the evaluators will select the top 10 skaters to advance to B1 Phase II.
- C. If there IS NOT a second B1 team at that level, all players from the final hour of scrimmage will go to B2 Phase II.

B1 Boys Phase II (Squirts)

If there is 1 B1 Team:

- B1 Coach will run Phase II and select the team. 5 Players will be cut to B2.
- All Players cut from A Squirt Phase II will automatically be placed on the B1 Team.

If 2 B1 teams are formed:

- B1 Teams will be Equal
- Two B1 Coaches will run Phase 2 together and then draft pursuant to the CYHA draft policy.

B1 Boys Phase II (Pee Wee/Bantam)

If there is 1 B1 Team:

- B1 Coach will run Phase II and select the team. Remaining players will be cut to B2.
- All Players including goalies cut from A Phase II will automatically be placed on the B1 Team.

If 2 B1 teams are formed:

- Teams will be Upper / Lower
- Upper B1 Coach will run Phase II and select his team. All others will go to Lower B1 team
- All players including goalies cut from A Phase II will be on the Upper B1 team.

A Goalie Evaluations

- 1 hr Goalie Drills plus Participation in Scrimmages.
- One goalie evaluator and the A level coaching staff will evaluate the A level.
- Each Evaluator will receive a goalie evaluation form for each goalie.
- Goalies may be moved to the B level tryout after the 2nd hour by Evaluators.

B Goalie Evaluations

- One or two independent evaluators will evaluate the goalies.
- Each evaluator will receive a goalie evaluation form for each goalie.
- All goalies will participate in all Phase I sessions.
- At the completion of the 4th session the evaluator(s) will determine which group each goalie will be placed for Phase II. This decision will be based on the talent level and the number of teams at that level.

Tryout Jerseys

- A. 1 Tryout Jersey will be given to each player.
- B. You will keep this Jersey throughout Phase 1 and Phase II
- C. Jersey will be cleaned and turned in to the team manager of the team you end up on.

Tryout Jerseys

- D. You are responsible for your Tryout Jersey. If you lose your Jersey you will be charged to replace it.
- E. We will not have “Extra” or “Spare” Jerseys if you forget your Jersey at home.
- F. If you lose your tryout jersey prior to the end of tryouts you will have to pay for the jersey before you are issued a new Jersey.
- G. Team game Jerseys will not be issued to your team until all tryout Jerseys have been returned.

Post Tryout Expectations

- An assessment of the CYHA Tryout Process will be solicited from the evaluators.
- A Post Tryout General Meeting will be held with the CYHA membership for feedback/comments.
